2) Request to pass the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Order (Award).

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Sir,

- 1) Your office has already published the said Order dt. u/s 3 G of the National Highway Act. 1956 , wherein our name is already shown as interested persons & also as affected displaced person/ family losing house/shop etc..
- 2) The Government of India , Ministry of Road, Transport & Highway, New Delhi has recently in December 2018 published the Manual of Guidelines

on Land Acquisition of National Highway, which clearly order that all the Rehabilitation & Resettlement benefits in the Second & Third Schedule of RFCTLARR Act, 2013 should be given for the compensation order (Award) declared from 01/01/2015.

- 3) In the present case the Sec.3 (G) compensation Order / Award is declared on dt. Hence, we are entitled to get all the Rehabilitation & Resettlement benefits under the said Manual of guidelines. As per Annexure- 5.1 we are entitled to get the following Rehabilitation benefits as we are affected displaced families from house/shop etc.. (A copy of relevant portion of the Manual of Guideline is attached herewith.)
- a) Provision of Housing unit in case for displacement – 50 sq.mtr. constructed House in urban areas OR Rs. 5.00 lakhs as per Government of Maharashtra Resolution dt. 27/08/2014.
 - b). Choice of Annuity / Employment.
One time payment of Rs. 5.00 lakhs per affected families. A person who is eligible for employment (as specified by Government of Maharashtra Resolution dt. 27/08/2014.)
 - c) Subsistent grant for displaced family @ Rs. 36,000/- & Rs. 50,000/- for Scheduled Castes.
 - d) Transportation cost for each displaced family Rs.50,000/-
 - e) Cattle shed / petty shop - Rs. 25,000/-
 - f) One time Grant to artisan & small traders Rs. 50,000/- (as specified by Government of Maharashtra Resolution dt. 27/08/2014.)
 - g) One time Resettlement allowance of Rs. 50,000/-
 - h) The payment of Stamp Duty & Registration fee on actual amount.

Therefore, you are requested to grant the above amounts by making appropriate Resettlement & Rehabilitation (Award) u/s. 3G of National Highway Act. 1956 with 15% p.a. interest thereon from date of Award and/ or from the date of possession taken till the date of the payment.
